DEVELOPMENT CHALLENGES IDENTIFIED DURING MEETING

Participants cited the following development challenges in order of priority:

- Poor governance.
- Poor physical planning.
- Gender inequality.
- High cost of production for farm produce.
- High levels of youth unemployment.

PROPOSED SOLUTIONS

- Improving efficiency in service delivery.
- Providing access to government procurement opportunities for the youth.
- Establishing public-private partnerships (PPPs) to enhance developments in the county.
- Enhancing food security and ensuring value addition in the agricultural sector.
