Zambia: Small Project Assistance (SPA) Program Supports Women's Group

Using a <u>SPA</u> grant from USAID, a Peace Corps Volunteer in Zambia helped a local women's group establish a garden to improve nutrition and help women build business skills. The garden expanded year-round access to nutritious produce, generated income for a local women's club, and created opportunities for women to start their own home gardens. Members of the group also gained valuable business and financial skills by marketing and selling seeds and using the profits to invest in new businesses.



Malawi: New Locally-Led Development Projects

Using Local Works funds, World Connect has launched 24 locally-led development projects in Malawi from April-September 2018. With more than \$65,000 in small grants through field partners such as the Young African Leader's Initiative, CorpsAfrica, the Segal Family Foundation, and vetted community-based organizations, these projects work to combat local challenges. Each project grant is less than \$3,000, serving as a direct, low-risk/high-reward investment in local

Systems Training for Local Actors

Local Systems Practice, a <u>co-created research initiative</u>, is developing a cutting edge systems training for local actors. The training will consist of three individual week-long modules:

- Introduction to Systems Thinking and Scanning
- · Actor Mapping and Network Strengthening
- Factors and Causality

 (BAA) co-creation workshops in Lilongwe, Malawi. These events will gather
