

# U.S. Response to the Venezuela Regional Crisis

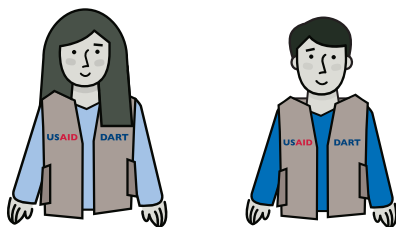
