SUBJECT: Information Requirement for all Grants and Cooperative Agreements to Non-Governmental

Organizations

CONTRACT INFORMATION BULLETIN 00 - 09

OMB has approved the Agency's information collection request under the Paperwork Reduction Act allowing USAID to require recipients to give a country-by-country breakdown of expenditure of program funds under a multi-country program covered by a single grant or cooperative agreement. The approval is in effect from May 2000 to May 2001.

All grants and cooperative agreements covering programs in more than one country shall include the following:

"Recipients shall list each country included in the program and the total amount expended for each country under the award for the reporting period in the "Remarks" block on the "Financial Status Report" SF-269 or SF-269A, or on a separate sheet of paper with the "Request for Advance or Reimbursement" SF-270.

This requirement will be included in ADS Chapter 303, however, in the meantime, please include the requirement, when applicable, in new grants and cooperative agreements and when amendments are made to existing grants and cooperative agreements. The OMB control number for this approval is 0412-0552.
