CONTRACT INFORMATION BULLETIN 99 - 9

This CIB supercedes CIB 98-10.

As a matter of policy, USAID provides a contribution against the actual costs of PSCs annual health insurance. As stated in paragraph 4(c)(2)(ii) of the Appendix D, such a contribution (1) shall not exceed 50% of the actual costs of the PSC's annual health insurance, and (2) shall not exceed the maximum U.S. Government contribution for direct-hire personnel as announced annually by the Office of Personnel Management.

For purposes of budgeting and making funds available, 1999 U.S. Government contribution rates for direct-hire personnel are as follows:

Contractor Only Not to exceed \$1,873.56
Contractor with Family Not to exceed \$4,170.14
