


PROPOSED ORG CHART FOR REVIEW — AUGUST 20 FUTURE USAID STRUCTURE

Through a series of employeeled and interconnected reforms, USAID will transform its STRUCTURE

- The proposed **changes to the Office of the Administrator** would more effectively manage the complexity of USAID's work by creating two Associate Administrators.
- The proposed Bureau for Humanitarian Assistance would advance our goal of seamlessly delivering food and non-food disaster aid.
- The proposed Resilience and Food Security Bureau would build resilient communities and countries, and improve water security.
- The proposed Conflict Prevention and Stabilization Bureau would strengthen our capacity to prevent conflict, address fragility, and respond to global crises.
- The proposed **Policy, Resources and Performance Bureau** would align Agency program and operating expense resources with development policy priorities.
- The proposed **Democracy, Development** and Innovation Bureau would reorient decision-making toward the field.
- The proposed **Bureau for Asia** would create stronger regional coordination and strategies, aligning to Interagency priorities.
